Explosion at Sea (Queen of Nassau)

EXPLOSION AT SEA: July 1926, South Florida. The luxury cruise ship, Queen of Nassau, leaves Miami for Tampa. Twenty-four hours later, a violent explosion sending the crew scrambling for their lives. In only 8 minutes, the ship is gone, not seen again until she's discovered in 2001. But the wreck beneath the waves conflicts with the crew's accounts of the sinking, and a mystery emerges. Deep Sea Detective John Chatterton joins forces with nautical archaeologist, Tane Casserley from NOAA's Maritime Archeology Center and divers from UNC-Wilmington's National Undersea Research Center to uncover what really happened to the Queen of Nassau. More than 75 years later, will the truth finally be revealed?
