**UNCW Policies on Academic Freedom and Tenure - Section VI: Non-Reappointment Hearings
Procedure for Tenure Track Faculty**

Part I: Appeal Rights

A faculty member may file a written appeal an unfavorable decision within ~~ten~~ fourteen calendar days after receipt of the chancellor's written decision to the Board of Governors. The review shall be in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Code Section 604D(2) and UNC Policy 101.3.1, section III.

UNCW Policies on Academic Freedom and Tenure - Section VII: Faculty Committee to Hear Grievances

Part B:

The committee shall be authorized to hear, mediate, and advise with respect to the adjustment of grievances of members of the faculty: ~~including those of "special faculty members"~~ as that term is defined in Section 610 of the Code.

Post Tenure Review Policy

Should the committee determine that the evaluation may have been based upon any of these impermissible grounds, it grants the faculty member a hearing ~~and either sustains the appeal or else confirms the previous evaluation. The committee's decision is a recommendation to the Provost or the Provost's designee, whose decision is final in accordance with Section VII of UNCW's Policies on Academic Freedom and Tenure and with Section 607 of the Code.~~
