# \$50,000 in scholarships

awarded for use during the 2008-2009 Academic Year

Scholarships have been awarded since 1990 by The National Association of College & University Food Services (NACUFS) in honor of Clark E. DeHaven for his outstanding leadership as the association's first executive director. In celebration of NACUFS' 50th anniversary, eligible students are invited to compete for one of 10 prestigious scholarships of \$5,000 each and be recognized as one of the rising stars in the foodservice industry.

## Who is Eligible?

Sophomores, juniors, and seniors planning for a career in the foodservice industry and majoring in a foodservice-related field of study.

## How Can the Scholarship Be Used?

The scholarship is intended to be used during the traditional academic year (fall through spring) for academic purposes such as tuition, fees, room and board, and/or books. Scholarships will be awarded for full-time undergraduate study only.

## When Are Applications Due?

Completed applications must be postmarked by **February 15, 2008** and received by the NACUFS office within one week.

- ❖ Students must be a U.S. or Canadian citizen and attending college in the U.S. or Canada during the scholarship award year.
