

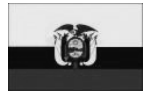

Spanish Major

Students must complete a minimum of 36 hours, including 202 and 203 or the equivalent and 30 hours at the 300-400 level, including at least 6 hours at the 400 level.

Spanish Minor

Completion of a minimum of 21 hours at the 200 level and above, excluding SPN 209, 210, 211, and 212. Of these, at least 9 hours must be at the 300 level or higher.
