

PROPOSAL FORMAT

1. Cover Page: As shown
2. Overview and Relevance of the Proposed Research: This and all other text should be prepared in a form clear to an audience that may be unfamiliar with your discipline; 2-3 pages in length. Conclude this section with a numbered list of objectives. Proposals in the humanities should state a rationale for the project; creative projects should specify genre and thesis.
3. Methods and Analysis (if applicable): 1-3 pages.
4. Literature Cited (or Bibliography) (may not apply to creative projects in the humanities).
5. Timetable for the project: Dates work will begin and end.
6. One-page vitae for each investigator, emphasizing research activities and accomplishments.
