To transfer to NCSU, a student must have a 3.0 overall GPA and a 2.5 GPA in the last two calculus courses taken.

Notes:

The EVS core is slightly modified to include 1 extra hour in the general core due to MAT 261. The resulting total is 70 hours.

The EVS core includes 3 hours to be transferred from NCSU (ST 370 replacing STT 215). 16 hours double count with basic studies, the maximum allowable in basic studies category E (BIO 201, CHM 101, and MAT 161, 162). Therefore $70 - 3 - 16 = 51$ hours.

$51 + 45$ (basic studies) = 96 hours taken at UNCW. $124 - 96 = 28$ hours that will be transferred back to UNCW from NCSU which includes ST 370.
